

# **Outdoor Burning & Cooking**



### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW


- There is no open burning permitted in the City of Surrey. This means that Cooking fires, campfires, and the burning of garbage are all prohibited.
- Chimneas or any other consumer product that is built for the burning of wood is <u>not</u> permitted.
- Natural gas, propane or charcoal briquettes are permitted as long as they are being used in ULC/ CSA-approved devices for that particular product.
- Outdoor burning of materials that are relevant to the continuation of farming is <u>only</u> permitted on land that has been classified as Farm/Agricultural land by BC Assessment, are actively engaged in agriculture/farming, and possess a valid permit issued by the Surrey Fire Service.



## **PREVENT FIRES**

- Cooking must be 10ft away from buildings or 3m away from any structure.
- Keep unused propane away from cooking devices.
- Properly secure propane so it doesn't fall over.
